Lawson, Rakuten join to test drone delivery system in disaster-hit Minamisoma

- 1) Convenience store chain Lawson Inc. and Japanese <u>cybermall</u> operator Rakuten have announced plans for a <u>demonstration test</u> on Oct. 31 of drone delivery services in an area <u>devastated</u> by the March 2011 earthquake, tsunami and ensuing nuclear disaster in Fukushima Prefecture.
- 2) The test will be conducted in the Odaka district in the city of Minamisoma, Fukushima Prefecture, <u>utilizing</u> an <u>outlet</u>, a <u>mobile</u> Lawson shop and Rakuten's drone.
- 3) When the traveling shop visits an area some 2.7 km from the convenience store in the <u>district</u>, it will take orders from <u>locals</u>. The drone will then deliver products, including warm cooked food, from the outlet to the moving shop.
- 4) The service will be <u>available</u> only on Thursdays during the test run over a period of six months.
- 5) The drone can carry <u>up to</u> 2 kg of products and deliver them in about seven minutes.
- 6) The central government <u>lifted</u> its <u>evacuation order</u> for Minamisoma in July last year after it was <u>imposed in the wake of</u> the <u>triple meltdown</u> at Tokyo Electric Power Co. Holdings Inc.'s <u>wrecked</u> Fukushima No. 1 nuclear plant.
- 7) Although residents have begun returning to their homes, there are few places to buy food and <u>daily necessities</u>.
- 8) Lawson President Sadanobu Takemasu said he hopes the service will <u>play a valuable role</u> in the community, where a number of older people have difficulty visiting stores. [2017-10-06 | JIJI]
